Putney TA13(2) – Putney Village Sidewalks Phase 2 Putney, VT

The Town of Putney will be accepting sealed bids for the Putney TA13(2) Sidewalk Project at the office of the Town of Putney at 127 Main Street, Box 233, Putney, VT 05346 **until 3:00 p.m. local time on April 14, 2017**, at which time all bids will be opened. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held for the project on Thursday, March 30, 2017 at 3:30 p.m. at the Town Offices in Putney, 127 Main St, Putney, VT. The work on the project includes construction of concrete sidewalks, installation of additional drainage infrastructure including storm drains and culverts, associated driveway and roadway paving, crosswalk striping, and other incidental work along US-5 in Putney. All construction activity is expected to be completed by August 1, 2017.

No bid will be accepted without a signed statement of intent to comply with these ordinances and a filled out Pre-Qualification of Construction Contractors Application.
